  - 1. NEOLA POLICIES 2<sup>ND</sup> READING- Enclosed is a copy of the NEOLA Special Release –May 2017 Board of Education Policy 5630.01. This policy has been shared with the Board of Education Policy Committee. First readings of these policies were done at the June 12, 2017 Board of Education Meeting.

  - 2. KRESA BUSINESS SERVICES SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT- At the June 12, 2017, Board of Education Meeting, the Board of Education directed the Superintendent of Schools to work with KRESA on the proposed 2017-2018 KRESA Business Services Shared Services Agreement.  
  
Recommendation: The administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the 2017-2018 KRESA Business Services Shared Services Agreement as submitted.
  - 3. EMPLOYEE CONTRACT SETTLEMENTS- At the June 12, 2017 Board of Education Meeting, a Closed Session for Strategy as it relates to Negotiations was conducted.  
  
Recommendation: The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the following Employee Contracts:
    - A. Administrative Base Salary Increase of 1% On Schedule To Be Implemented for the 2017-2018 school year.
    - B. Maintenance/Custodial Wage Increase of 1% On Schedule To Be Implemented for the 2017-2018 school year.

1. ADMINISTRATIVE CONTRACTS-Adjustments to Administrative Contracts are an Annual Action Item. Adjustments for this year include dates, medical hard cap information, additional base salary increase for the secondary principal, assignment to functions of above 5% increases to 16-17 and 17-18 contracts as appropriate, and language changes to reflect end of year performance evaluation timeline.

Recommendation: The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve Administrative Contracts as submitted.
