IX. NEW BUSINESS

1. MASB 2017 DELEGATE- Delegate Assembly will begin Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Lansing Center. Certification of the official voting delegates and alternates who will represent the Gobles Board of Education must be certified by Friday, October 13, 2017.

Recommendation: The administration recommends that the Board of Education appoint a delegate and an alternative delegate to represent Gobles Board of Education for the 2017-18 school year.

2. LEGENDARY TEACHER DAY RESOLUTION- This day is an initiative that was started by a former Gobles student/alum and retired Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Nicholas Clement. Legendary Teacher Day is a day to reflect on a teacher who has had a positive impact on our lives.

Recommendation: The administration recommends adoption of a resolution proclaiming Legendary Teacher Day to be September 28, 2017.

3. I LOVE PUBLIC EDUCATION RESOLUTION-This resolution is a national initiative originated by AASA, the National Superintendent Organization.

Recommendation: The administration recommends adoption of a resolution in Support of Public Education.

4. RESTORATIVE JUSTICE/SECLUSION RESTRAINT- Two new laws take effect for the 2017-2018 school year that regulate how school district and schools manage student behavior.

Recommendation: For informational purposes only.

5. LEARNING RESULTS-Recently, SAT, Advanced Placement, and MSTEP Learning Results were released. The administration will provide an overview of these metrics.

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6. ELEMENTARY ENROLLMENT UPDATE-The administration has been tracking enrollment starting with before school and continuing through today, Monday, September 11, 2017. An update will be provided.

Recommendation: The administration recommends hiring one additional paraprofessional to support enrollment numbers at the elementary.

7. FACILITIES- Bid opening for the Controller Projects took place on Thursday, September 7th at 1:00 p.m.

8. 2017-18 PERFORMANCE EVALUATION MODELS- State of Michigan Legislation 380.1249 requires that the Board of Education for a School District adopt for all Administrators and Teachers a rigorous, transparent, and fair performance evaluation system from a list of approved researched based models.

Recommendation: The administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the continued use of the School Advance Performance Evaluation Model for administrators and the Five Dimension Performance Evaluation Model for teachers.
