REVISION

During the Mandatory School Closure, Gobles Public Schools Food Service has been offering a grab-n-go breakfast and lunch pick-up and delivery every day starting March 18, 2020. This service will continue through March 24, 2020. On March 25, 2020, we will adjust our service to an every other day pick-up and delivery through April 12, 2020. This change is to implement “best practice” and to limit exposure for both patrons and staff members as well as to reflect the March 23, 2020, Michigan Governor Mandatory School Closure extension. The new schedule will be as follows: On March 25, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for both March 25, 2020 and March 26, 2020. There will be no service at school on March 26, 2020. On March 27, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for March 27, 2020, March 28, 2020, and March 29, 2020. There will be no service at school on March 28, 2020 and March 29, 2020. On March 30, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for both March 30, 2020 and March 31, 2020. There will be no service at school on March 31, 2020. On April 1, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for both April 1, 2020 and April 2, 2020. There will be no service at school on April 2, 2020. On April 3, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for April 3, 2020, April 4, 2020, and April 5, 2020. There will be no service at school on April 4, 2020 and April 5, 2020. On April 6, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for both April 6, 2020 and April 7, 2020. There will be no service at school on April 7, 2020. On April 8, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for both April 8, 2020 and April 9, 2020. There will be no service at school on April 9, 2020. On April 10, 2020, breakfast and lunch bags will be available for pick-up for April 10, 2020, April 11, 2020, and April 12, 2020. There will be no service at school on April 11, 2020 or April 12, 2020. Meals can be picked up at the front door of the Middle School/High School entrance located on M-40. The meals will be available for pick up on service days only between 9:00 am – 11:00 am.

Meals are for students 18 and under. Children do not have to be present to pick up the meals. An adult can come and inform the volunteer how many meals you need for the children in the household. Children do not have to attend Gobles Public Schools to receive a meal.

If there is an issue with being able to leave your home and come to the school to pick up your meals, please call 269-628-9345 one day in advance. This practice will continue through March 24, 2020. Starting with March 25, 2020, this timeline will change. The new schedule will be as follows: Delivery requests will need to occur on March 24, 2020 for March 25, 2020 and March 26, 2020. Delivery requests will need to occur on March 26, 2020 for March 27, 2020, March 28, 2020, and March 29, 2020. During this call, you will need to provide us with the following information: A household name, the number of meals that you will need, and your bus route. We will plan to have meals brought to your house between the serving times the next day after your call. Someone will need to be available to come out to the delivery vehicle to receive the meals.

Lastly, if you are in need of further food supplies, please reach out to our local community food pantry. Thank you for your understanding and patience during this process.
