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GOBLES PUBLIC SCHOOLS BOARD OF EDUCATION OPEN MEETING MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 8, 2018

I. CALL TO ORDER

Board President, Mr. Russ Aspinwall, opened the regular Board of Education Open Meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the Gobles MS/HS library.

VIII. OLD BUSINESS

1. WORK SESSION/COMMITTEE MEETING STRUCTURE- The Board of Education discussed alternative meeting structures to conduct the organizations business.
2. GOVERNANCE COMPACT- The recently completed five year organizational Strategic Plan identifies Board of Education review/modification of the Governance Compact as a 2018-2019 action item. This will be for approval at the regular scheduled November meeting.
3. 2018-19 SUPERINTENDENT GOAL SETTING-I, Mr. Daniel Baker move, that the Board of Education approve the 2018-2019 Superintendent goals as submitted. Motion was seconded by Mr. Terry Doyle. **MOTION CARRIED 6-0, 1 ABSTAINED.**

IX. NEW BUSINESS

1. ALTERNATIVE REVENUE STREAMS REPORT-Mrs. Julia Baker updated the Board of Education on the status and progress of her activities.
2. LEARNING RESULTS- SAT and MSTEP Learning Results were released. Administration provided an overview of these metrics.
3. ENROLLMENT UPDATE- The Fall 2018 Count Day was October 3, 2018 and Count Submission to the Michigan Student Data System will be November 14, 2018.
4. STUDENT EXPULSION- On September 19, 2018, a manifestation determination review meeting was held for Student A. It was determined by majority vote of the MDR team that student A's actions was not a manifestation of student A's disability.

I, Mr. Terry Doyle move, that the Board of Education move into closed session according to MCL 15.268, Section 8(1). Motion was seconded by Mr. Daniel Baker. **MOTION CARRIED 7-0.**

and extending 180 school days. Student A may reapply for reinstatement no sooner than after 150 school days, which would be Monday, May 13, 2019. Motion was seconded by Mr. Daniel Baker. **MOTION CARRIED 7-0.**

5. CLOSED SESSION-Open Meetings Act, Act 276 of 1976

I, Mr. Terry Doyle move, that the Board of Education go into Closed Session pursuant to 15.268 Closed sessions; permissible purposes, Section 8 (a) To consider the dismissal, suspension, or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, or to consider a periodic personnel evaluation of, a public officer, employee, staff member, or individual agent, if the named person requests a closed hearing. Motion was seconded by Mr. Brian Beam. **MOTION CARRIED 7-0.**

The Gobles Board of Education moved into closed session at 9:54 p.m.
